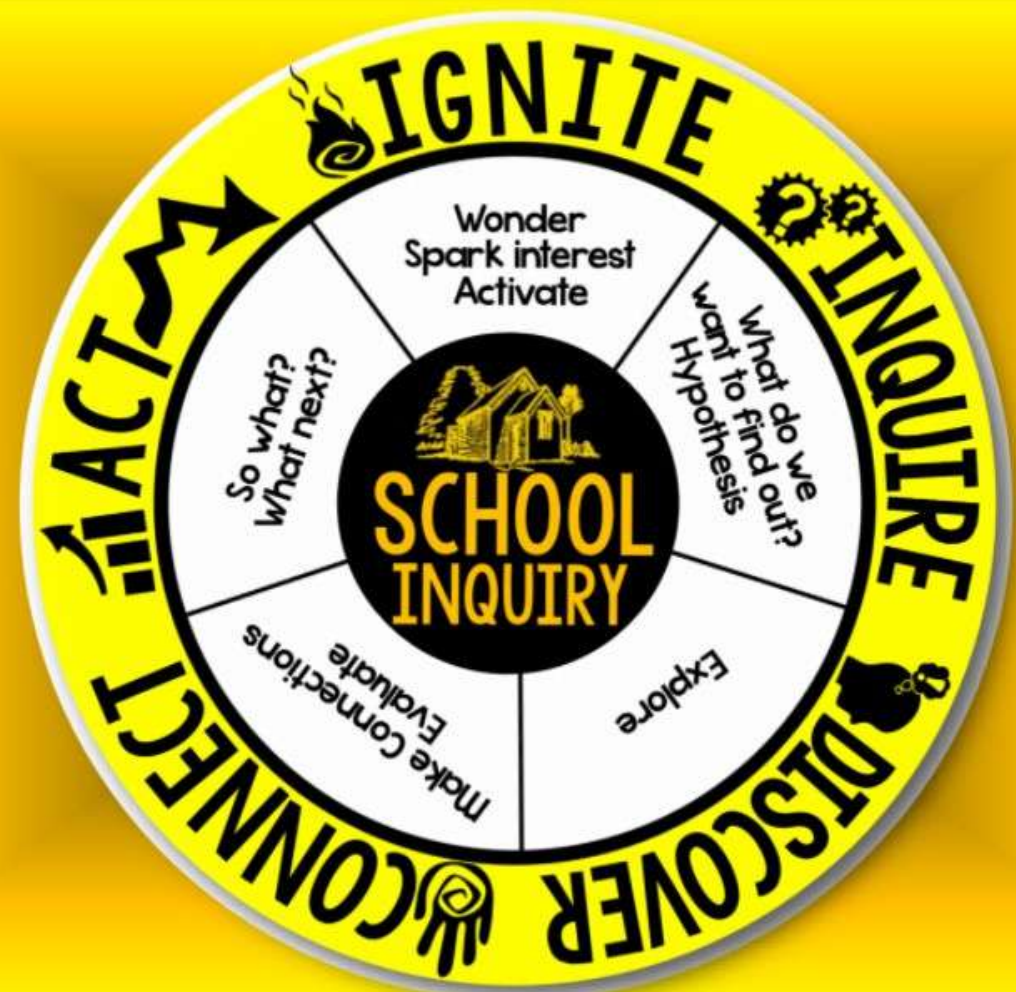


INQUIRY
